We gathered at Good Shepherd Church, Subang Jaya on 14<sup>th</sup> morning and left after a breakfast fellowship. We reached All Soul`s Church, Cameron Highlands at 3pm for a Tea fellowship with Archdeacon Jacob George, his wife Sylvia and a few church members. After the warm welcome and prayer by Archdeacon, we left to Orang Asli Village, Kg Terlimau.

At the Kg Terlimau, we were all welcomed by the locals there. A communion service by Archdeacon Jacob George was held, after which a dinner fellowship which was hosted by All Soul`s Church members. We blessed about 21 Orang Asli families with provision items.

The next day morning after breakfast fellowship, the ibu ibu and us went to the farm to do some harvesting of vegetables. Indeed it was a great experience in the hot blazing sun for all of us. Later in the afternoon, it was time with the ibu ibu and the children. The Children`s Ministry was coordinated by Sis. Victoria and Sis. Christine for about 35 children. The children enjoyed their handy-crafts making of wind chimes & hand fans. The children were so excited with the activities and they also received goody bags after their session. As for the Women Ministry, there were 25 ladies who attended the session. Sis. Veni shared the word of God. After that the baking and the making of the Chocolate Cake, a steaming method was used which was demonstration by Sis. Ponnumoney. While the cake was steaming, Sis. Veni demonstrated the 3 ingredients Cookies. All the ladies were so happy and they even participated in making of the cookies. Both the cakes and cookies were enjoyed together with all the villagers which was perfectly baked and steamed. Gifts and toiletries items were given out to all of them. Cengkodok pisang” and ginger tea were served for tea fellowship for the ibu-ibu which was prepared by us.

In the evening at the dinner fellowship, a delicious “sambal tumis chili padi” which was prepared by one our sister was served which was a big hit. After the delicious meal, the Fun and Sharing sessions was held with the locals including all Women, Men and Children. Together we sang, danced and praised God. Sis. Ponnumoney organized games which got all of us involved as we bonded together and had a wonderful time of fellowship.

The next day morning, it was time for us to head back home after a breakfast fellowship and saying goodbye to all the ibu-ibu and children for a great & special time we had together. Even our journey was not a smooth one but with God grace we all reached safely. All glory to God.
