The SPM Bible Knowledge paper (Code 9221) is offered by the Lembaga Peperiksaan Malaysia for the Sijil Pelajaran Malaysia (SPM) examination every year. We thank God that Bible Knowledge still exists in our examination system. All Christian students are encouraged to take this subject.

Why should Christian students take Bible Knowledge at SPM Level?

- 1. Christians need to know God's Word.
 - SPM BK covers 2 books of the Bible: The life and teachings of Jesus Christ as contained in the Gospel according to **Luke** and the growth of the Early Church in the **Acts of the Apostles**. These 2 books help build faith and enrich our Christian living.
- 2. It is an investment of time for eternity.

In today's busy world, spending time studying BK is investing for eternity. Jesus said in Luke 21:33, "Heaven and earth will pass away, but my words will not pass away."

- 3. BK is the anchor that students need for these times of turmoil.

 We live in difficult times of uncertainty, fear and anxiety. God's Word helps us find meaning and purpose in life. We need to stand on God's Word as our Anchor.
- 4. BK provides students with a moral compass.

Moral decay is prevalent today. How would one know what God says unless he/she is taught God's Word? "How can a young man keep his way pure? By guarding it according to your word." Psalm 119:9 ESV

- 5. The church in Malaysia needs strong leaders for tomorrow.

 BK prepares students to be responsible adults and godly contributors to society.
- 6. Taking BK for SPM is a testimony that our Christian faith means something to us.

Let us work together in our churches to increase the BK candidature so that we would not have to lament one day when it is gone because there are no takers!



DWM Bishop's Trophy for SPM Bible Knowledge

Purpose: Mission and Evangelism

Objectives:

- a. To encourage students to take Bible Knowledge as a subject for SPM.
- b. To increase knowledge of the Bible, in particular the books of Luke and Acts.
- c. To promote Anglican schools as a centre for Bible Knowledge.
- d. To empower the Board of Governors in managing the affairs of the school and empower Christian heads and teachers to motivate the students.

Eligibility: (SPM 2023: Date of exam: 6 March 2024)

- Form 5 students at the 5 Anglican secondary schools in Peninsular Malaysia who take the SPM Bible Knowledge paper.
- Anglican students studying in other mission schools, government schools and private schools who take the SPM Bible Knowledge paper.
- Non-school candidates who are members of an Anglican church who take the SPM Bible Knowledge paper.

Prizes:

- Students who score an A+ for SPM BK from an Anglican school or a member of an Anglican church: RM1000, a certificate and the Bishop's Trophy.
- Students who score an **A** for SPM BK from an Anglican school or a member of an Anglican church: **RM500** and **a certificate**.
- Students who score an **A-** for SPM BK from an Anglican school or a member of an Anglican church: **RM250** and **a certificate.**
- Students who score a **B+ or B for** SPM BK from an Anglican school or a member of an Anglican church: **RM100** and a certificate.
- Students who score **C** or **D** for SPM BK from an Anglican school or a member of an Anglican church: **RM100** and a certificate.
- Non-school candidates who are members of an Anglican church who take the SPM BK paper and obtain a minimum C: a token of appreciation and certificate from the Diocese.

Administration

- Prizes for the A+ students to be presented by the Bishop at the Anglican school during the school prize giving day or equivalent.
- Prizes for the best BK student(s) for each Anglican school to be presented by the Chairperson of the Board of Governors (or AMSB representative) at the Anglican school during the school prize giving day or equivalent.
- Prizes for non-Anglican school students to be presented by the Vicar of the parish.
- Prizes for non-school candidates to be presented by the Diocesan Bishop at Wisma Anglikan.
- Funding period 2023-2028
- Other administrative matters related to the DWM Bishop's Trophy will be managed by the Anglican Mission Schools Board (AMSB).
