1.0 Movement of Clergy

- 1.1 Rev. Paul Khoo Boo Huat has been appointed as Priest in Charge of Emmanuel Harvest Centre, Sg. Ara, Penang with effect from 1st January 2024.
- 1.2 Dss. Dr. Tan Swee Bee has been posted to serve in Joshua Community Centre JCC, Seremban with effect from 1st November 2023. She continues to serve as Chaplain to the Anglican Students in STM.

- 2.3 These Evangelists will start preparing themselves for ordination as deacons and commissioning as deaconess in 2024.

3.0 Consecration of Assistant Bishop, Diocese of Sabah and Provincial Gathering 2023 (PG2023)

- 3.1 The Consecration Service of Canon Kenneth Thien as Assistant Bishop was held at All Saints' Cathedral, Kota Kinabalu on 5th November 2023. The Provincial Gathering 2023 (PG2023) was held in Kota Kinabalu from 6th to 9th November 2023.
- 3.2 In all, around 300-350 persons attended the PG2023, with the largest delegation (159 delegates) coming from Diocese of Kuching. The Diocese of Singapore was also well represented. The Diocese of West Malaysia was represented by 10 delegates (smallest delegation).
- 3.3 The PG2023 started off with a grand Thanksgiving Dinner for the Consecration of New Assistant Bishop Kenneth Thien and Opening of PSEA Gathering at the Hakka Hall on 6th

November. Members of churches of the Diocese of Sabah entertained the guests with melodious songs, traditional music, and multi-cultural dances. An instant photo booth was set up for guests to take back a memento of this memorable occasion.

- 3.4 We spent most of the 2nd Day at All Saint's Cathedral, beginning with the Opening Service, and followed by talks by Bishop Ng Moon Hing on the Theme "Growing Stronger Together In Faith" and "Growing Stronger Together In Mission". After lunch, we participated in the Inter-Diocese Challenge Trophy (which was retained by the Diocese of Sabah) at the Hosanna Hall. Games included Quizzes, Nail-Hammering Relay, Hula Hoop Crossing Challenge, Penalty Shootout, and Coconut Bowling. The evening was "free & easy" for everyone to do their own thing in Kota Kinabalu.
- 3.5 The 3rd Day was packed with outings to the Highland (Nabalu Market, Desa Dairy Farm in Kundasang), Island (snorkeling near Mamutik Island), and Lowland (Kota Kinabalu City Tour). Dinner on the 3rd day was hosted at the All Saints' Cathedral by 15 parishes in the Kota Kinabalu area, giving us a taste of their own home-made dishes served "stall-style" by the church members.
- 3.6 On the 4th Day we said our goodbyes and returned to Kuala Lumpur after a sumptuous buffet breakfast at the hotel. We would like to thank the Diocese of Sabah for organising a meaningful, fun-filled and memorable Provincial Gathering. They were gracious and generous hosts, and all the delegates were well taken care of. New friends were made, and old friendships rekindled. Kudos to the Organising Committee led by Bishop John Yeo for a job very well done! Their hard work and meticulous planning was evident in the smooth running of the programmes.
- 3.7 The next Provincial Gathering will be held in 2027, and will be organised by the Diocese of West Malaysia. Let us rise to the challenge!

4.0 Appointment to Boards
