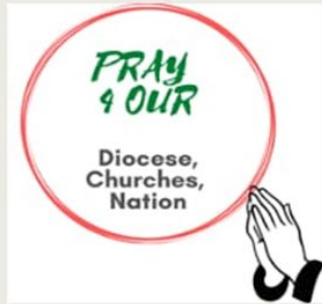

1st – Thursday

PRAYING DIOCESE: A General Thanksgiving
