

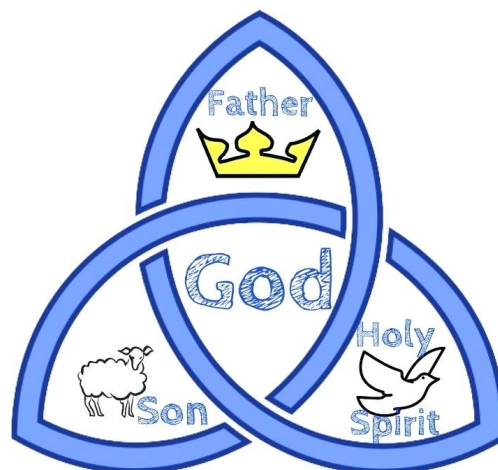

- Heal families carrying burdens of sickness, grief, financial struggles, and emotional pain. Provide for every family facing financial hardship, unemployment, debt, or uncertainty.
- Teach families to seek God together through prayer, worship, and reading of Your Word. Remove every generational curse, bondage, addiction, and destructive pattern affecting families.
- Fill every home with the presence of the Holy Spirit, bringing joy, peace, and spiritual renewal. Raise families that will shine as witnesses of Christ's love and faithfulness.

20th – MONDAY
